- The water **is boiling**. Can you turn it off?
- Let's go out. It **isn't raining** now, **it's snowing**.
- What are **you doing** in the kitchen, dad?

2. A temporary situation:

- I **am staying** with my friends for the holidays.
- At Christmas I've **got** a lot of **shopping** to do.
- Are **you learning** to wrap presents?

The present continuous has two parts! am / are / is + verb + ing

I **am** playing

you **are** playing

he **is** playing

she **is** playing

it **is** playing

we **are** playing

they **are** playing

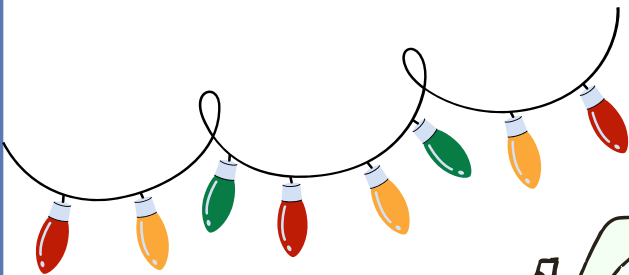

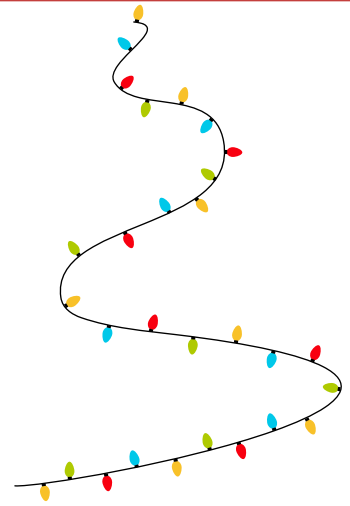

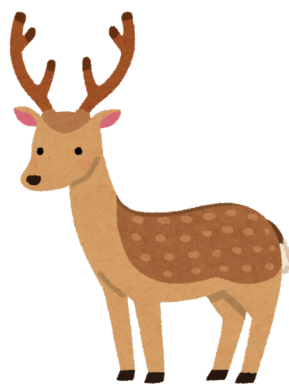
