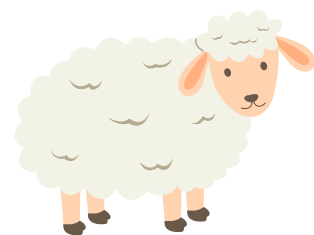

Adjectives can even describe how you are feeling.

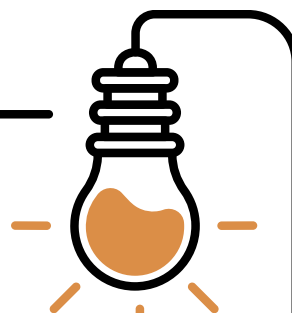
You can use adjectives to positively describe something.

- Delicious

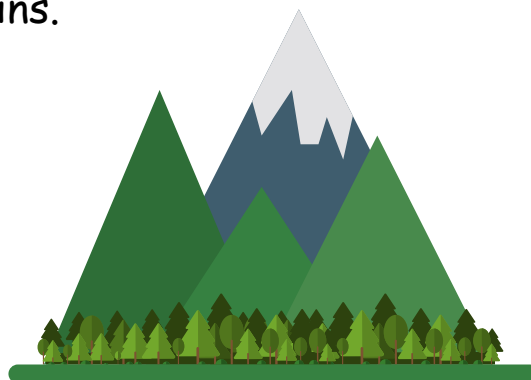

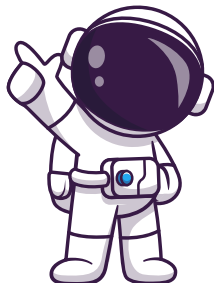

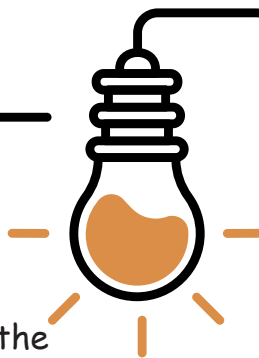
